



Stormwater Best Management Practices For Kitchen Facilities



DOs

Do clean equipment such as floor mats, exhaust filters, garbage cans, carts, or tray racks in a designated indoor area such as a mop sink or floor area with a drain connected to the sanitary sewer.

Do protect garbage & grease dumpsters from rainwater by keeping lid closed & replace leaking dumpsters.

Do keep dumpsters locked to prevent illegal dumping.

Do apply absorbent over any fluids spilled in the garbage dumpster & sweep up litter around dock area.

Do insure grease traps are properly maintained and cleaned often to prevent clogs & overflows.

Do properly dispose of leftover commercial cleaning products.

DON'Ts

Don't pour wash water down a storm drain, on ground or in a gutter.

Don't place liquid waste or leaky garbage bags into a dumpster.

Don't hose out dumpster interiors.

Don't clean dock area by hosing into a storm drain.

Don't pour grease, oil, or large quantities liquids such as sauces or salad dressing down a sink, floor drain, storm drain, or into a dumpster.

Don't pour cleaning products down a storm drain.
